Introduction

Future Success Sports is committed to ensuring a safe environment for all staff, participants, and visitors. We comply with the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974, FA health and safety regulations, and The FA's Safeguarding Children Policy & Procedures.

Responsibilities

- Directors act as Health and Safety Officers.
- Risk assessments conducted before all activities to ensure facilities etc are safe.
- Emergency procedures in place and communicated to all staff, participants, and relevant stakeholders. Any updates or changes will be reviewed and communicated promptly.
- First aid provision and trained staff at all sessions.
- Designated first aider present at all sessions.
- Compliance with The FA's Guidance for Safer Working Practice.
- Emergency evacuation procedures in place.
- Regular safety drills conducted.

Implementation

- Regular safety audits and risk assessments.
- Incident reporting and response procedures.
- Continuous safety training for staff and volunteers.
- FA Emergency First Aid in Football (EFAiF) training required for relevant staff.
- Records of incidents and responses maintained for compliance, including periodic reviews to identify patterns, improve safety measures, and ensure adherence to FA safeguarding protocols.
- Compliance with FA best practices for safeguarding and risk assessment.
- Reporting procedures for serious incidents involving The FA or relevant external bodies.

Review and Updates:

This policy will be reviewed annually by the company directors to ensure compliance with UK regulations and FA guidelines. The review process will include assessing updates to relevant legislation, FA policies, and best practices, as well as feedback from staff and stakeholders.
